It was fairly tight up until the last few overs when the equation was well and truly in their favour – 6 runs, 19 balls and 3 wickets. Nothing was impossible but Pendle Hill were patient and scored the winning runs with 2 overs to spare. Josh Balzarolo picked up 2 wickets (2/17), supported by Matt McKenna (1/8), James Benton (1/12) and Sam Shiel (1/12). We effected a few good run outs to put some good pressure on Pendle Hill.
