How it works

At 3-45, we were in need of a partnership. Yassar Saiyed (55 runs) and Vishal Patel (26 runs) took the score to 3-73 at the 20 over break. Their partnership was broken at 99 but we continued to score at 6 runs an over to post a challenging total of 186.

The captain, Ajaz Khan, took a wicket in his first over but it was left to Grant Walker (1-10) to take the vital second wicket and dismiss Greystanes' century maker from round one with a well pitched left arm inswinger that was well taken by the keeper, Rizz Patel. Greystanes mounted a challenge in the middle of their innings but they were kept in check by accurate bowling, some good catches (three from Vishal Patel) and a direct hit run-out (from Ian Renton). Noman Dar, second on the B13 runs tally with 350 runs, turned his hand to bowling in this game to finish with the best figures of 3-34.

B13 had its seventh successive win of the season. Yet again, Ajaz Khan won the toss so we could get runs on the board on a hot day. At 3-57, we were struggling on the small, fast ground of Greenup Park but batting depth has been our strength all season. Firstly, Dinal Patel (69 runs) combined with Vishal Patel (36 runs) in a classy partnership of 79 runs. Then, Noman Dar (40 runs) dominated a sixth wicket partnership of 56 with Ian Renton (48 not out). The innings was finished off nicely when Ian combining with Jesse Xu (23 not out) in an unbroken 8th wicket partnership of 70 runs in 9 overs.

Chasing an unlikely score of 304 runs in reduced overs and flagging in the heat, it was no surprise to see Hills Barbarians succumb quickly for just 94 runs. The bowling honours went to Vishal Patel (5-31) and Grant Walker (2-29). Vishal's 25th wicket of the season has moved him to second place on the B13 wicket tally.

Despite 9 of the 11 batsmen making some sort of start, the highest individual score was only 21 from Romesh Liyanage, with sundries actually top scoring with 23.

123 did not seem to be enough given the fine weather and fast outfield. Guildford started in positive fashion reaching 2 for 45 and then 3 for 52 before the next 6 wickets fell for just 7 runs to leave Guildford at a precarious 9 for 59. A last wicket partnership of 15 runs wasn't enough and Baulko claimed the last wicket to run out winners by 49 runs. The collapse was triggered by Nirav Goradia who followed his 5 wickets in round 8 with 6 for 23 off 5.3 overs. He received great support from Romesh Liyanage with 2 for 15 off 5 overs.

A very important win enabling Baulko to move back into second place on the table but greater application needed with the bat and improved catching to seriously challenge for the premiership in March.
