At last. We have broken our losing streak for the season!

Bowling first, it was a reasonable start with some tight bowling that kept the scoring rate low. Last time we played Auburn, we gave away extras at the rate of over 2.6 per over. This time around, we bowled less than half that, at just 1.2 per over on average, which shows how much the boys have improved over the season. We managed to restrict them to 6-131 from their 52 overs, which is a pretty good effort given that they have a few players that consistently get scores. Pick of the bowlers was Oscar Turner with 2-13. A special mention to Sharman who filled in from the Under 10s, and was the most economical bowler with 0-4 from 4 overs. In the field, Sahil Goyal showed that fielding practice is paying off, with 4 catches.

There was much anticipation about Day 2, but unfortunately it didn't look very promising from the start. There was a bit of rain around overnight, but it was reasonably clear at the scheduled start. Whilst the pitch was a little wet, it was nothing a broom couldn't fix and no worse than we had played on before, so we were keen to play. Unfortunately, the opposition were concerned that the pitch would be too slippery for their bowlers and the fielders might catch a cold by getting wet feet from the grass, so play was abandoned for the day. Perhaps a wise decision in hindsight given the downpour that was to follow later in the morning.

The result – A Draw. Not as satisfying as a win, but we can claim the opposition was not prepared to take us on, so perhaps a moral victory.

Again the bowlers were well supported with fine catching by Patrick, Josh and Tom Cunningham who took a great slips catch. Suddenly Rouse Hill were 7/119 and the Baulko boys were on top. To the credit of Rouse Hill they continued to fight hard with some big hitting and they put on a ninth wicket partnership of 53 off 10 overs to finish the day at 8/183.
