The combined age of 110 years for the openers may not be a record but it is rare. Ian and Pete comfortably got through the first session without trouble to leave Baulkham Hills 0-45. In the second session, the run rate increased only slightly but the captain was pleased to see Baulkham Hills at 0-93 after the second session. We finally lost our first wicket in the third session but an opening partnership of 122 meant that the openers had beaten their age by 12 runs and set a platform for a big score. Ian Renton was out soon after for 59 runs. He had beaten his age also but was just pipped by Sundries at 60 as the top score. Sean Hampstead (45 runs) joined Dinesh Bhardwaj (38 runs) to take the score to 2-190 but after that wickets fell regularly and in the end we did well to get to 250 in fading light.

In the second week, an early wicket from Lachlan Weekley (2-42) failed to curb the fast scoring by Winston Hills. At 1-73 in 40 minutes, Winston Hills threatened to chase down our score but two quick wickets from Sean Hampstead (3-14) put us back in the ascendency. From then on wickets fell regularly and despite a late flurry from Winston Hills, we secured first innings points by 53 runs.

A spectacular diving caught and bowled by David Banks was the highlight of the second day. Eight catches (from seven different players) out of 12 chances was good. Five different wicket-takers was also good but conceding 43 sundries and bowling at well over 5 runs an over was not so good. The best part of the win was that several players contributed with either bat, ball or in the field.
